

Christian Attitudes

Part A Why do you need to be a Christian?

1. To get to heaven

There are only two kingdoms: That of God and that of Satan. Whatever happens on earth is a result of these two kingdoms working in the life of a person.

The Kingdom of God is in heaven and the kingdom of Satan is in hell but He also rules the world as Jesus has not claimed it yet and His followers are not claiming it for Jesus.

You follow the principles of one of these two kings: either Jesus or Satan (even if only by rejecting or ignoring what Jesus requires you to do) and the king whose principles you follow is the one you go to be with when you die.

If you follow Jesus you go to heaven otherwise you are following Satan and will end up with him in hell.

2. To avoid the punishment of eternal death that results from our sins.

Hell is God's best incentive plan for following Jesus as your Lord!

What is Eternal death and how did we become a victim of it?

Eternal death is separation from God for eternity and results from rebellion (disobedience) against God. Everyone has disobeyed God's authority at some time in their life so sin and will suffer eternal death when they die.

All earthly authority is placed over you or allowed to be over you by God and, unless they ask you to do something against God's rules, they must be obeyed.

The spiritual death resulting from your sin places a barrier between God and you and defiles you spiritually so that you cannot go and be with God when you die but go to the other place (hell).

The results of sin remove us from The kingdom of God and from being able to have a personal relationship with Him and places us in the kingdom of His enemy, Satan. If you do not decide to follow Jesus you will go to Satan's kingdom when you die.

If you follow Jesus you are removed from Satan's kingdom and are now in The Kingdom of God as a Citizen of it and will go to be with God when you die. You go to the kingdom of the king you are following when you die.

What Jesus did!

The sacrifice of Jesus at Calvary did not save us. Jesus redeemed us there! Salvation has always been through obedient faith in Jesus and is not just a decision to follow Him but an active maintaining of all that is required to follow God.

God saw that mankind could not meet the requirements of removing the punishment of Sin and that only Jesus could do it. So, Jesus was sent to earth to redeem us from the punishment of our sins.

Jesus Redeemed us

When you redeem something, you buy back from someone the right to own something they have taken from you in some way. By His death Jesus took from Satan his right to own us after death and gave it back to The Father. But it is only for those who follow Jesus as their Lord.

By His death, Jesus met the requirements of God for the punishment for our sins so that we no longer have to suffer this punishment in hell.

But only those who wholeheartedly and voluntarily follow Jesus are redeemed.

Jesus desires us to follow Him because we appreciate what He has done for us and Love Him sufficiently for this to obey Him in all we do.

Demons obey Jesus because they have to and not because they want too.

By His death, Jesus removed the defilement of Sin that was on us and met all that was required to restore us to a relationship with God.

God now sees us unpolluted by Sin and adopts us as His Child so that we can now relate personally to God on a 24/7 basis

We become a Citizen of The Kingdom of God and no longer are a citizen of Satan's kingdom of hell. God provides all we need on earth and forever, after death, in heaven.

Jesus is our King. The Father our provider and The Holy Spirit our guide and teacher in all things.

Eternal life is a result of a relationship with The Father and Jesus (Jn 17:3). Salvation and redemption are necessary to have this relationship.

How do we maintain our Christian life?

Salvation is a relationship with The Father and Jesus guided by The Holy Spirit and we need to maintain our side of this relationship.

Obedience

We need to obey His Laws and requirements of us which requires us to study His Bible to know what these requirements are. It is a voluntary decision we have to make and apply wholeheartedly too and Satan will do anything he can to stop us doing what we need to do to serve Jesus and develop our relationship with Jesus.

We must be able to hear the guidance of The holy Spirit when it is necessary so we know what God desires us to do in a situation when The Bible is not clear about it.

It must be wholeheartedly done or we risk serving Satan and going to hell if we do not turn back from a half-hearted attempt to follow Jesus as our Lord.

Unless he is your Lord, He cannot be your saviour and Redeemer.

Holiness

Holiness is an attitude of chasing after God and His things and rejecting all around you that the enemy (Satan) tried to have you accept. So, it requires an effort as you usually have a demon opposing you trying to stop you in some way to pursue holiness and not to avoid the traps of Satan's smokescreen.

The world around you is run by Satan and is designed to hide Jesus, Heaven, Hell, Satan, the kingdom of God and everything that promotes God. It is a smokescreen set up by Satan to stop your pursuit of Holiness and of your getting to heaven.

Holiness is required to go to heaven and be with God. If you do not pursue holiness then you are following the things of Satan.

A person living a holy life expresses the character of God in all they do (or at least tries too).

Our Status as a Citizen of The Kingdom of God

We need to understand our status as a citizen of The Kingdom of God to understand our relationship to God as a servant of His.

We are adopted as His children into the family of God but we also have roles as a Citizen of His Kingdom. He is our Ruler as well as our friend and we need to know our responsibilities as His servant.

Our status in The Kingdom of God resulting from the death of Jesus

We are now declared Righteous (which simply means we are in a correct relationship with God)

God Sanctifies us (God sets us apart from the world as belonging to Him)

We have 24/7 unhindered access to God because of this

God declares we are His Citizen with all the rights, roles, responsibilities, and rewards of a citizen

God gives us all the protection, resources and help we need to serve Him.

Our part in this arrangement

God desires we do things for Him voluntarily out of love for Him and out of appreciation of what He has done for us

We now must live by the rules of The Kingdom of God so we:

- We need to study to know what they are and they are found in The Bible

- We need to study to know how to do His Will correctly

- We now need to have the attitudes of The Kingdom of God

 - Towards God

 - Towards others

 - Towards ourselves

- We now need to do the work of The Kingdom of God as Faithful Stewards looking after what He has given us to be a steward of, representing God and defending and advancing The Kingdom of God

- We now need to pursue and develop our relationship with God by learning about God, what He has done for us at Calvary as well as what He has done for us in our life.

- We need to practice Holiness through concentrating on the things of God so we are focussed on the King and His Kingdom and not the things of his enemy that surrounds us in the world.

- We need to show God's quality of Love to all which will be Expressed in our attitude to God and His things which include His lost children and what others are stewards of.

In Summary

A Christian is a voluntary follower of Jesus as their king and who express His values and purposes in their life

How you become one? You make a decision to follow Jesus as your ruler and reject all His enemy, Satan, offers you

What are the rewards of being a citizen of the Kingdom of God:

You will have eternal happiness in heaven with Jesus

You will escape spiritual death in hell

You will have a personal relationship with God

you will have rewards in heaven for services rendered to God

How do you stay a citizen of the kingdom?

You need to know God's requirements and how to serve Him correctly

You need to learn and have correct attitudes

You need to know how to fight god's enemies

You need to know how to hear The Holy Spirit your guide, His teachings, and directions

It is a lifestyle thing staying focused on Jesus and his will for you rejecting all Satan tries to have you do or tries to place a you.

It is a decision you must make:

You only have one chance at life on earth

Nothing is worth holding onto if it takes You to hell

A person is a fool who will not let go of something on earth they cannot keep and lose for ever what they can never lose – that which God keeps for them for ever in heaven

Part B The Character of a Christian

The whole objective of God is to make our character to be like His so that we will be prepared how to express ourselves in heaven so that we will relate to Him and others correctly.

On earth we learn to develop the character of God in us by our obedience to God regardless what happens to us. He states that all that happens to us is for our best so we need to trust His love toward us no matter what happens as He is in control of all circumstances using them for our eternal best, even though it may not seem so at the time.

There are no accidents God or it would be out of his control and He would not be God

Remember, we cannot understand that the mind of God and what He has planned for us so we need to trust and not use earthly reason (which Satan tries to have us do) to try and work out what God is doing for us at that time.

In fact, Jesus tells us in Matt 6:33 not to worry about the future but to do what He requires us to do each day and the rest will be taken care of by Him.

So, you need to know how you are to think as this is what expresses you character and the what follows will show you the correct attitudes to have in what you do each day.

When you become a Christian, you begin a lifestyle journey to put into practice what it means to be a Christian. This means you must learn how to live as one and develop the attitudes required to live as one. Demons confess Jesus is Lord but do not live as He requires them to live. So being a Christian is more than just declaring Jesus is Lord!

Anyone who says they follow Jesus but does not live as He requires them to do is following the lifestyle of demons and will not go to heaven. It is only those that confess Jesus as Lord and show it by their lifestyle, expressing His Character, who will go to heaven.

God's Purpose

God's purpose for us is to believe in Jesus:

John 6:29 Jesus answered, "The work God wants you to do is this: to believe in the one he sent."

To do this we must develop an intimate relationship with The Father and Jesus and appreciate His Love for us so we will know who He is and what He has done for us and appreciate Him sufficiently to be motivated to follow Him.

We must learn all we can about Him and His requirements of us so we can relate to Him as we should and live in a way that pleases Him which will also be best for us.

He desires us to serve Him out of love for Him and appreciation of what He has done for us. Fear of hell is not a good motivation for serving Him, but it does help to realise what happens if you do not obey Him as Lord.

Jesus said in John 14:15 If you love me, keep my commandments.

A sign of the love with Jesus is that we obey Him

Praise, adoration, worship, obedience, and love for Jesus are a result of our appreciation of what He has done for us, is doing for us and will do for us as is also our serving Him out of love for Him.

The importance of God's perspective in looking at things

You must always look at things in the way God looks at things so that you will apply His values and requirements and not be influenced by Satan's way of thinking which is expressed in the world system and its values that are always around you. (Satan makes certain of that)

If you do not know how God's principles and values apply to a situation, then ask The Holy Spirit. He has been sent by God to guide you in all the things you are to do with or for God as well as to teach you what you need to know to be able to do them (Job 32:8, Jn 16:13, Jn 8:32, Duet 29:29).

Attitudes to have

It is important to have God's quality of love. Love in the way He does and you will always do what He requires of you (Jn 13:34-35). This will be the foundation of all our attitudes if we are to express the Character of God in all we do.

We are to submit ourselves completely to His Will (Rom 12:1-2)

We are to trust His Love, because whatever He allows to happen to you will always be for your best (Rom 8:28).

We are to seek Jesus and His things in all you do (Col 3:1-2, Matt 6:33).

Your objective should be to seek God's Will in all you do and develop the relationship you have with each member of The Trinity (Matt 6:32-34).

You must work at your side of the relationship you have with God and seek to maintain the obedience this requires (Phil 2: 14-15).

Your thoughts must always be pure and wholesome (Phil 4:8, Matt 12:36).

You must always be guided by the Holy Spirit (Rom 8:14, Jn 16:13).

You must serve Jesus in the way He desires you to serve Him, encouraging others to do what He requires of them (Heb 10:24-25).

You must believe God rewards His followers. That all you did for God on earth was worth doing. You must believe it will be all worthwhile and that all the rewards you have in heaven will be worth all you suffered on earth (Heb 11:6.)

You must endure to the end and finish the work God has for you on earth (1 Cor 15:58, Matt 24:13). It is on earth that we learn the attitudes we will use in heaven and it is only as we endure trials to their end that we will learn these as we should.

You must realize that when you affect another Christians, you really affect Jesus (Matt 25:40).

The attitudes expanded.

The basic altitude is unswerving, loving, obedience to Jesus. Jesus must be ruler of all you do. He does not ask you to obey Him out of fear of going to hell but out of love,

appreciation, and thanksgiving for what He has done for you.

In John 14:15 He specifically stated:

“If you love me, keep my commandments.”

Love is the basis of all Christian obedience and “Love for Jesus” is the basic attitude for the expression of all other attitudes of the Christian life.

God’s type of Love is the expression of The Spirit of God’s presence in you and is expressed as: joy, peace, long-suffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, meekness, temperance (Gal 5:22-23). It is through these expressions of God’s type of Love to others that God shows His character through you.

Because of what Jesus has done for us, we should submit our self to Him.

Rom 12:1.I beg you therefore, my brethren, by the mercies of God, that you present your bodies living sacrifices, holy and acceptable to God by a logical service.

Jesus redeemed us and paid the price God required to remove from us all the spiritual punishment for our sins, that would have resulted in our going to hell, as well as the defilement we had which prevented us getting into heaven. In other words, He delivered us from going to hell and removed the requirement to sacrifice to God for our sins as well at restoring us to a personal relationship with God so we could be with him in heaven.

Because of this, we are always able to be in a proper relationship with God so that The Holy Spirit can guide us and we can always approach God continually.

Our primary reason for submission to Jesus is the love for, appreciation of and thankfulness we have toward Jesus for what Jesus did for us at Calvary as well as what He is doing for us now on earth and will do for us in heaven.

We need to submit to Jesus so we are always where we should be so He can use us and meet our needs and help us along the path prepared for us from before creation on which is every good thing God has prepared for us.

We are told also to focus on the things of Jesus and to reject all that Satan offers us through the world system he controls and which is designed to distract you and guide you away from the things of Jesus as well as to blind you too them.

We need to change our attitudes and thoughts so they are changed from the ways we used to think (based on what we saw in the world around us) to that with Jesus desires us to focus on.

Coll 3:1. If therefore you are risen with The Messiah, seek that which is above, the place where The Messiah sits at the right side of God.

2. Feed on that which is above and not that which is in The Earth,

3. For you have died to yourselves and your lives are hidden with The Messiah in God.

4. And whenever The Messiah, who is our life, is revealed, then you also will be revealed with him in glory.

We are to focus on the Will of Jesus for us. It is He who is our ruler, who, through Calvary, freed us from the punishment of sin and the bondage Satan had placed on us and removed us from Satan's kingdom. So, if we a follower of Jesus we will focus on His requirements of us and this focus will keep us from doing what Satan desires us to do.

Your mind should be occupied solely with His teachings and His will for you. To focus on the things the world (controlled by Satan) offers you, is to take your eyes off what Jesus requires of you. So that you may end up disobeying Him in an area or no longer be a follower of Him.

You no longer should be in control of your life's purpose as you have offered it to Jesus to be Lord of. So, that now, your future hope and plans are tied up with the Will of Jesus for you This will also result in the life that is best for you although you may not realise it at that time.

Matt 6:31. Therefore do not be concerned or say, 'What will we eat?', or 'What will we drink?', or, 'What will we wear'?

32. For the Gentiles are seeking all these things, but your Father who is in Heaven knows that all these things are necessary for you.

33. But seek first the Kingdom of God and his righteousness, and all these things will be added to you.

34. Therefore you shall not be concerned about tomorrow, for tomorrow will be concerned for itself. A day's own trouble is sufficient for it.

We should always be seeking the will of God and to improve the relationship we have with him. We should not be concerned about our needs as God promises to provide all we need if we focus on His Will and developing the relationship we have with Him. In fact, v34 is almost a command not be concerned about the future, which you will not be if you trust completely God's plan and preparation for your life and in this attitude, you will be spared the worries people usually have about their future.

Satan uses his world system to try and distract us from God's Love and provision, so we will worry and be anxious. If we believe in God and His Love for us, Satan cannot distract us. We will trust God for our needs and not worry about them or be anxious about anything.

Only in this attitude of complete trust in God's Love, Control, Purposes and Plans for us is their true peace and contentment. This is a result of having no anxiety or worry because you know God is in control and whatever happens is for your best.

If Satan can get you to not trust God's Love toward you, he can torment you. You must trust God completely, or He is not your Lord!

Phil 4:6. Do not be worried for anything, but always in prayer and supplication with thanksgiving, let your requests be known before God,

7. And the peace of The God, Who is greater than every mind, will keep your hearts

1 Peter 5:7. And cast all your cares on God, for he takes care of you.

We are told to give our fears, worries and anxieties to Jesus to be Lord of as He will deal with them and help you go through them. He framework of The Five Steps helps you in this.

If you trust Jesus and His Love, you will ask him to help you. After all, that is what friends are for and Jesus is the best friend you will ever have.

When you wholeheartedly follow Jesus as your Lord, The Father in Heaven adopts you as His son and then you are not just a friend to Jesus, but He is now your step brother through your adoption by The Father.

This is why you need to learn to spend time with Jesus and The Father. After all, who does not want to spend time with their beloved father and step brother.

Rom 8:28. But we know that he helps those who love God in everything for good, those whom he preordained to be called.

Phil 2:12. Therefore beloved, just as you have always obeyed, not when I am near to you only, but now when I am far from you, all the more, with awe and with trembling, do the service of your life.

13. For God is carefully working in you both to desire and to do that thing which you desire

If you love Jesus, you will spend your time developing your side of the relationship. You will take whatever steps are needed to do this.

You will learn whatever you need to learn. You will do whatever you need to do. You will spend with Him whatever time is necessary to do this.

You will always trust that God is always working for your best so that you will never complain about what He is allowing to happen to you. You will trust His Love for you in whatever circumstances He allows to happen to you. He is Control of all your circumstances and Satan can do nothing to hinder Jesus in this.

Job 32:8 But there is a spirit in man: and the inspiration of the Almighty giveth them understanding.

Jn 16:13. "But whenever The Spirit of The Truth comes, he will lead you into the whole truth, for he will not speak of his own will, but he shall speak whatever he shall hear and he shall reveal the future to you."

Rom 8: 14. For those who are led by The Spirit of God, these are the sons of God

The Holy Spirit is your guide and is the person God has sent to help you in your Christian life. You will need to be able to hear his guidance and teaching as well as to trust this guidance and teaching. He also loves you and all he does is for your best. So, you need to develop your relationship with Him and walk with one spiritual ear always listening to Him.

Phil 4: 8. Therefore, my brethren, those things that are true, those that are honorable, those that are righteous, those things that are pure, those things that are precious, those things that are praiseworthy, deeds of glory and of praise, meditate on these things.

Matt 12: 36. For I say to you that every idle word that people will speak, they will give an answer for it in the day of judgement.

37. For by your words you will be justified and by your words you will be condemned."

Every wrong word you say you will need to explain to Jesus why you said it.

If you are led by the Holy Spirit, your focus will only be on good things that come from God and not on the things of Satan, which are unholy, and defiled and which anyone that deliberately does them cannot enter The Kingdom of God. You will also express these good things in your life to others.

If you love Jesus, you will only say and do things that promote the King and His Kingdom accepting only thoughts that do this and rejecting all of Satan that would hinder your doing this in your life:

this Heb 10:25 not forsaking the assembling together of ourselves, as is the custom of some, but exhorting, and by so much more as you see the Day drawing near.

You will also think of how Jesus desires you to serve others. We serve Jesus our King, and He tells us whom He wants us to serve as well as how He desires us when and how to serve them as well as to encourage others like He encourages us.

Remember that the five-fold ministries are gifts to serve people and not to control them.

Mat 25: 40 And The King answers and says to them, 'Amen, I say to you, as much as you have done to one of these my little brothers, you have done that to me.'

This is why Jesus says that whatever we do to others we do to Him. They belong to Him and The Father anything we do to any part of His Kingdom we do to Him.

It is Him we obey and show His quality of Love as we serve others. So how we express His type of Love to others is how we affect the demonstration of His quality of Love to them. They are also all children of The Father and what we do to them in a sense we do to Him.

Heb 11: 6. But without faith, no one can please God, for whoever is brought near to God must believe that he exists and that he is the rewarder of those who diligently seek him.

As we serve God, out of Love for Him and those we serve, He has rewards for us. He asks us to believe He will reward us through His doing all He said He would do for those who followed Him.

Faith must trust God and part of this trust is in Him rewarding us for this service we do to him. Even though He, as a King, does not need to reward us for the things He commands us to do.

Our primary reward is a relationship with God. This relationship results in salvation as well as the release of every good thing God is able to give you (other rewards).

Matt 24: 13 But whoever will persevere until the end will have life.

1 Cor 15: 58. From now on, my brethren and beloved, be steadfast; do not be shaken, but be abounding at all times in the work of THE LORD JEHOVAH, as you know that your toil has not been worthless in THE LORD JEHOVAH.

He requires us to wholeheartedly try and finish all He asks as too do and to endure all Satan does to us. By this we will show our love for Jesus and that He is our Lord.

God allows trials for three purposes:

To show Satan we are worthy of the ministry God has called us too or are doing at that time. This is when Satan is allowed to test us usually in a way that tests us too our limits maturing us and preparing us for a ministry.

To mature us to a greater level so God can use us more

To draw us back to the path we were on prepared by God from before creation but have now diverted off. Repentance of our wrong activity or attitude is necessary attitude for this to occur.

Only as we endure and fulfil the test God is putting us through will we be matured and prepared the way He needs us to be for the ministry He is preparing us for. When we pass the trials that do this for us, Jesus will declare before Satan that we are worthy of what He is to give to us to do and Satan will not be able to complain about our ministry authority.

Trials are a sign of His Love for us so that we should never complain about the trials we are going through. To do so is to doubt His Love.

God loves you as you are

God is a God of Love. If He did not love you as you are He would be a hypocrite.

He knows your potential and seeks to develop you so that you will reach it and be the best Citizen of the Kingdom that you are able to be.

It is ironic that, when in a trial, He seems so far away and uninvolved. But He is honing you and using the circumstances to make you a better and a more useful citizen of His Kingdom.

The Christian life is really God helping you to reach your full potential as a citizen of the Kingdom, to prepare you even for a better life in eternity with Him.

The mark of a Christian is that in everything they do, they demonstrate God's Quality of Love.

Your life objective, should be to know the Will of The King, Jesus, and to carry it out in His quality of Love.

This will result in the maintenance of your salvation relationship with Jesus and The Father as well as your continual maturing and preparation for life in heaven.

When you look at the visions of hell Jesus has given people you will see Jesus point out many in hell who called themselves Christians, But who did not do what Jesus required of them.

To be a follower of a person you must practice what they teach as well as do what they require of you.

Unless you are doing wholeheartedly or at Least wholeheartedly trying to do what Jesus requires of you. Then you are not following Jesus and will suffer the fate of all those that do not follow Jesus.

How Should His Love affect us?

You need to love others in the way that God loves them. It is a command (Jn. 13:34-35) so there is no choice in this. There is no escape clause or other way out of this commandment. It must be obeyed! Deliberately not doing so can result in loss of salvation.

You must understand God's type of Love shown to yourself and others because then you will be able to love in the way He loves.

Remember that there is only one type of Love and that its physical expression is what is different which depends on The Bible, the culture, and the relationship it is being expressed in.

You need to trust God's Love and express this through the principles of Mat 6:33 that, as you, through faith seek a deeper relationship with Him and the expansion of His Kingdom through your unquestioned obedience to His Will, He will provide all you need to do His work and show His love towards others in all you do.

To become a follower of Jesus will cost you all that you have but in return you will gain riches unimaginable in heaven, after your physical death, which you can never lose.

The Christian life is a choice you make. It is up to you to maintain it and express it in the way God desires you to express it. God will help you as much as you let Him, but ultimately what happens to you is a result of the choices you will make.

Choose wisely because you are in hell an awfully long time if you deliberately make the wrong choices.

1 Corinthians 15:58 Therefore, my beloved brethren, be ye stedfast, unmoveable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, forasmuch as ye know that your labour is not in vain in the Lord.

Part C What is our work for Jesus

The mission statement of Jesus was as follows:

*(Luk 4:18-21) The Spirit of the Lord is upon me,
because he hath anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor;
he hath sent me to heal the brokenhearted,
to preach deliverance to the captives,
and recovering of sight to the blind,
to set at liberty them that are bruised,
To preach the acceptable year of the Lord.*

And he closed the book, and sat down. And the eyes of all them that were in the synagogue were fastened on him. And he began to say unto them, This day is this scripture fulfilled in your ears.

His example was as follows (Matthew 4:23):

And Jesus went about all Galilee,
teaching in their synagogues,
and preaching the gospel of the kingdom,
delivering people from the effects of Satan on them
and healing all manner of **sickness** (short term sickness)
and all manner of **disease** among the people (long term chronic).

This is what our objective should be:

The last words of Jesus to His people can be summarized as follows:

"All power (authority) is given unto me in heaven and in earth.

Go ye therefore, and teach all nations I have risen,

*Baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost:
Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you
And that repentance and remission of sins should be preached in My name among
all nations, beginning at Jerusalem.
He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be
damned.*

And these signs shall follow them that believe;

In my name shall they cast out devils;

They shall speak with new tongues; They shall take up serpents;

*And if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; They shall lay hands on the
sick, and they shall recover*

And, lo, I am with you always, even unto the end of the world."

These actions will be observable in the life of a follower of Jesus as an expression of God's quality of Love in them working through them to others.

Obedience to Jesus will result in The Kingdom of God being demonstrated in and through our lives and we will demonstrate it as He commanded us too in Mark 16:17-18.

Evangelism

Evangelism is a fancy name for telling others about Jesus.

Evangelism is really telling people what Jesus has done for people in the kingdom of Satan to deliver them from this kingdom as well as how He has affected your life as a result of your accepting what Jesus has done for you and can affect their life also.

If you love others with the same quality of Love that Jesus Loves them with, you will go and tell others what He has done for them so they can enjoy what you have received as a result of your accepting what He has done for you. To not do this shows you are hypocritical or fearful and need training to do these things.

Do not be concerned if you do not know how to do these things. The Holy Spirit promises to teach you all you need to know to do them and will bring people and information to you to help you to learn about doing this in the way Jesus desires you to do it.

You are only ever required to tell others what you know and this is all God asks you to do. But you also need to learn how to become a Christian so you can tell others which in a sense is what evangelism does.

If you are able to do this but do not bother too when Jesus asks you to do it then you risk going to hell, unless you repent and do it. If you do not do it when told by Him or given the opportunity to do this then you have rejected Jesus by rejecting what He has asked you to do.

If you deny Him or knowledge of Him in any way, you have also rejected Him and He will reject you before the Judgement Throne of The Father so that you cannot go to heaven. The only other place you can go to is hell.

There are many people in hell who rejected what Jesus desired of them to do, yet still called themselves Christians (implying they were His followers).

How you deal with these attitudes is up to you. You have free will and it is your choice what you do with it. So, you will have no one else to blame if you disobey God and end up in hell.

The race is not to the swiftest, or to the smartest or the most intelligent. It is to those who humbly obey and endure to the end in all Jesus asks them to endure.

If you love people as The Father loves them. You will always have before you their eternal destiny and good. And you will have one ear on the Holy Spirit to see what God wants you to do or say to them (if anything).

You do not Minister to all. But only those God desires you to Minister too and then you only say or do what he desires you to say or do for them.

This is why you must always be guided by The Holy Spirit. So that you will always be ready to do or say what God desires you to do or say.

Part D How to hear The Holy Spirit

The Holy Spirit usually does not appear to people and if He does so it is in a dream or vision and not on earth as a person (spiritual or physical) and even then, these dreams or visions are very rare. We normally only hear His activity in our mind as a thought

He speaks to our soul placing godly emotions and thoughts in it which we express in the physical realm.

He will place thoughts in our mind which we will think are our own and wonder how we came to think that wonderful or Godly thought.

He will never use the feelings of our body; however, emotions and feelings may result what he does for you. Satan, however, uses them to try and get our bodily lusts to control our will so he can use your flesh to cause us to sin.

When The Spirit is working in us, we will have peace or apprehension and we wonder why we have it. Peace if it is what God desires us to do. Apprehension, if it is not what God desires for you because it is a temptation of Satan trying to make us do something wrong.

These Godly thoughts and understandings are from The Holy Spirit and because they come through our souls, we do not realise it is Him talking to us in some way.

So, any thought that gives us peace or a warning apprehension is from Him because when we sin there is no longer a warning or apprehension but a lack of peace because we are not in a correct relationship with God and are being convicted by The Holy Spirit that we need to repent and turn back to what Gods desires us to do.

Any thought that raises lust in us or the desire to do a wrong thing is from Satan

Remember that Satan too speaks to us in the way The Spirit does and tries to make us believe the thought or emotion/feeling is from us.

So, examine the thought and see if you have peace over it or if it is Godly and if it is not or makes you apprehensive or takes away your peace then attack the demon behind it.

Conclusion

the Christian life is a choice you make which, if you are serious about, you will do all you can to live correctly. There are only two rewards life: you either go to heaven or hell. If you believe the Bible then you will do everything you can avoid hell and get to heaven.

The choice is yours and you will have no one else to blame for where you end up.

You cannot live the Christian life alone so seek out someone whom you know is a good question and ask them to help you and teach you. It must be someone who has proved the Christian life and you know are mature Christians.

The father, Jesus and the Holy Spirit are always there waiting to help you so do not be afraid to ask as their promise is they will always help and guide you.

Salvation is a relationship and it is up to you to develop your side of and to do all you can to maintain it.
